

Ayhan Enacar Case Presentation Award

This award is presented during the International Congresses of Turkish Orthodontic Society, in memory of Prof. Ayhan Enacar.

Prof. Ayhan Enacar, a doyen in Turkish orthodontics, was born in 1954, in Ankara, Turkey. Having started his education in Barbaros Primary School, Dr. Enacar completed secondary school in Yenimahalle Secondary School and completed his high school education in Tevfik Fikret High School. He received a part of his high school education in Strasbourg Gimnase Jean Strum in France where they moved to due to his mother's profession. He started studying dentistry in Ankara University in 1971. He took violin lessons from Prof. Koral Çalgan ever since his primary school years to his faculty years.

His poems, written during his years in Ankara University, School of Dentistry, were published in the journals, "Türkiye Yazıları", "Türk Dili" and "İlgaz". Between the years 1977-1979, he was given a spot in the "promising poets" section of "Varlık Yıllığı" journal alongside his peers Enis Batur and Murathan Mungur.

Having graduated from Ankara University School of Dentistry in 1976, he started his postgraduate studies in orthodontics in Hacettepe University, Faculty of Dentistry, in 1977. He became a specialist in 1981, and an Associate Professor in 1985. He was appointed as a Professor in 1993. He founded the Orthodontic Society upon his teacher Prof. Serpil Aytan's request. They later changed the name to "Turkish Orthodontic Society" along with Prof. İlder Uzel. He was elected the President of the Turkish Orthodontic Society in 2000. He was a member of The Turkish Orthodontic Society, European Orthodontic Society, World Federation of Orthodontists, Cleft-Palate Craniofacial Association, and The New York Academy of Sciences.

Prof. Ayhan Enacar had numerous national and international publications, wrote books and chapters. Apart from national and international congress presentations,

and presenting lectures on “Bioprogressive Theraphy”, Dr. Enacar contributed to the education of many orthodontists.

The application requirements for the Ayhan Enacar Case Presentation Award are listed below:

1. The case presentation shouldn't be published before.
2. Presenter of the case report should be under the age of 40 and he or she should be member of Turkish Orthodontic Society. Presenter author should register to the congress.
3. The candidate must apply to the award with an abstract and must upload a 5-slide-long presentation of the case before the abstract submission deadline (using the additional files / full paper submission button). The case presentation will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee and the author will be notified about its suitability for the Ayhan Enacar Case Presentation Award.
4. The case presentations that have been accepted as candidate of the award will be presented during the congress and they will be evaluated by scientific committee. Case presentation that has the highest score will be granted with the award.
5. Decision of the Scientific Committee will be announced during the congress.
6. The Turkish Orthodontic Society reserves the right to determine the amount of Ayhan Enacar Case Presentation Award.
